A spokesman of the Uttar Pradesh government today said that a Facebook post attributed to Chief Minister completely untrue and baseless and informed that after the Facebook officials were contacted, the said post has been deleted from the account.

The spokesman further informed that the state government has taken a grim view of the post which was posted in the name of the Chief Minister from a fake account. It was found out in initial probe that the fake post had emanated from Assam, after which police there was immediately contacted and swift effective action was requested.

The Inspector General of Assam informed the state government that a case has been registered against unidentified miscreants in Panbazaar for trying to stoke hatred and bitterness in the society under section 153 (A) of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) - crime number 332/17 and a probe has been initiated thereafter.
