

**Chief Minister takes immediate note of the fire at
Trauma Centre at KGMU, asks officials to rush
and oversee relief and rescue work**

**Instructions issued to douse fire at the earliest and
take necessary action to bring back normalcy**

**Officials also asked to make alternate arrangements
for patients admitted at the Trauma Centre**

**Divisional Commissioner, Lucknow asked to
probe the matter and present a report within three days**

**Accountability of the guilty should be fixed so

Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath ji has taken immediate note of the fire at Trauma Centre at King George Medical University (KGMU), asks officials to rush and oversee relief and rescue work at war footing.

He also issued instructions to douse fire at the earliest and take necessary action to bring back normalcy. Orders have been also issued to ensure that there was no chaos and that patients admitted at the Trauma Centre are shifted to alternative place for treatment.

Terming the incident as sad and unfortunate, the Chief Minister has instructed the divisional commissioner of Lucknow to probe the matter and present a report within three days so that accountability of the guilty should be fixed so that action could be initiated against them. Also, to ensure that such incidents are not repeated in the future.
