Addressing the gathering, the governor said that the day was very pious and pointed out how many brave warrior sons of the soil had laid down their lives to protect their mother land from foreign aggressors. Soldiers are the pride of the nation, he added further while observing that their contribution to the country can never be forgotten.

In his address, Yogi Adityanath ji said that the ultimate sacrifice of life given by hundreds and thousands of brave soldiers to safeguard the territorial integrity of the nation will never be forgotten. He also

exhorted every citizen of the country to express their gratitude towards these brave men. On July 26, 1999, the Indian soldiers had held the tricolor high and defeated the cowardly act of the Pakistani forces, he added.

Yogi ji further said that there cannot be a bigger sacrifice than to lay ones life in the line of duty.
