Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath ji has praised the bravery of the martyred sub-inspector Mr. JP Singh and has announced a financial assistance of Rs. 50 lakh to his family. Of this Rs. 40 lakh will be provided to his wife and Rs. 10 lakh to his father-mother. It may be pointed out here that of the Rs. 50 lakh to be given to the martyred sub-inspectors family, Rs. 25 lakh would be given by the state home department and Rs. 25 lakh from the Chief Minister's Discretionary Fund.

The Chief Minister has also announced that a gate will be built and a road renamed after the martyr in his ancestral village Banevara in Jaunpur district. Other than this, the martyr will also be awarded a bravery medal. It may be also pointed out here that amount equivalent to one day salary of all police men of the districts of Jaunpur, Lucknow and Banda range will be given to the family of Mr. JP Singh.

Consoling Mr. Shyam Bihari Singh, father of the martyr, over phone, the Chief Minister said his son had laid down his life to maintain peace in the society and added that his sacrifice will not go waste. On directives of the Chief Minister, Minister of State for Rural Development (Independent Charge) Dr. Mahendra Singh met the family of the martyred sub-inspector earlier today at his village.

The minister expressed grief and extended the condolences from the Chief Minister and on behalf of the state government to the bereaved family. He also made the family speak to the Chief Minister on phone. The Chief Minister told the family that they were with them in this hour of grief.

It may be mentioned that Mr. JP Singh was martyred in a police encounter with dreaded bandits in the jungles of Manikpur in district Chitrakoot.
