

Following directives from the Chief Minister, district magistrate of Varanasi gets Priya and Shiva admitted to a school

The children also provided free-of-cost dress, books, socks and shoes

Following directives of Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath ji, the district magistrate of Varanasi has, in 24-hours, got Priya and Shiva admitted in a school for studies. Six-year-old Shiva has been admitted in LKG while 8-year-old Priya has been admitted in UKG at the Tulsi Niketan Balika Inter College, Hukulganj near their home.

As instructed by the Chief Minister, these children were also given free dress, books, shoes and socks etc. It may be pointed out here that on the second day of his two-day tour to Varanasi, on Sunday, during inspection of Pt. Deendayal Upadhyaya Government Hospital, the Chief Minister spotted these two children sitting with the attendant of a patient.

The parents of the children told the Chief Minister that due to poverty they were not able to send Shiva and Priya to school, after which Yogi ji had issued instructions to the district magistrate to get the children admitted to a school. He also directed the legislator Mr. Ravindra Jaiswal to arrange for free books, copies, socks, uniform and shoes for them.

On Monday, as soon as the school opened, the two kids are admitted to a school near their home.
