

**Chief Minister visits the injured labourers of the NTPC, Unchahar mishap at various hospitals, enquires about their well being**

**CM enquires about each injured labourer at every hospital**

**Doctors directed to ensure proper treatment of injured labourers**

**Chief Minister soon after arriving in Lucknow visits SGPGI, Dr Shyama Prasad Mukherjee (Civil) hospital and the trauma centre at KGMU**

Uttar Pradesh chief minister Yogi Adityanath ji today visited various hospitals and enquired about the well being of the injured labourers involved in the mishap at NTPC, Unchahar unit in Rae Bareli. He enquired from the doctors about the condition of the injured and directed them to ensure proper treatment of the injured.

He visited each and every injured labourer at each hospital. The chief minister soon after his arrival from Mauritius at the Lucknow airport drove straight to the SGPGI, met the injured labourers and the doctors attending on them. After this, he went to the Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee (Civil) hospital and the trauma centre at KGMU.

The injured labourers of NTPC are undergoing treatment at these hospitals. The chief minister also spoke to the officers of the NTPC who briefed him about the incident on Wednesday. It may be recalled here that many labourers had died at the NTPC power plant in Unchahar on Wednesday and many more were injured.

As soon as the chief minister came to know of the incident, from Mauritius itself, he directed the officers concerned to personally oversee the rescue and relief operations. He had also announced that the injured would be treated free of cost at the government hospitals.

Also present during the chief ministerial visit were Medical Education minister Mr Ashutosh Tandon, Principal Secretary (Medical Education) Dr Rajneesh Dubey, Principal Secretary Medical and Health Mr Prashant Trivedi and Principal Secretary (Information) Mr Avaneesh Kumar Awasthi.
