**Chief Minister sees presentation on
'Personalized Transit System'**

Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath ji today saw a presentation on alternatives of Metro, at his Shastri Bhawan office here and said that the State Government was exploring options to ease traffic in cities in view of growing pressure.

He also informed that the State Government was continuously looking for options to do so. During the presentation, the Chief Minister was informed about the 'Personalized Transit System'. Yogi ji stressed on the need to study the subject and also understand the viability factor of the system.

The Chief Minister said that for implementation of such system or any other system, it was imperative that a detailed study of the same is undertaken and the viability factor looked into.

It may be pointed out here that under the 'Personalized Transit System', driverless pods (cars) will play on structures made on columns and will automatically reach the passengers on their pressing a button. This would work on 'Always On, Always Available' concept and will take the passenger to the destination non-stop. At present, this is world's most modern transport system.
