extends sympathies to the bereaved families**

**Families of victims to get Rs. two-two lakh  
each as financial assistance**

**Instructions given for adequate treatment to those taken ill**

**A joint-probe to be conducted by

Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath ji has termed the Barabanki incident saddening and has extended his sympathies to the bereaved families. He has also announced a financial assistance of Rs. 2-2 lakh each as financial assistance, to the families of the deceased.

Providing this information, a state government spokesman informed that the Chief Minister has also issued instructions to the Principal Secretary Health to ensure adequate and proper treatment, including dialysis, to those taken ill in the incident.

The Chief Minister has also directed the Principal Secretary Excise and Principal Secretary Home to get a probe conducted by a joint team of the excise and the home department.
