Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister has termed the rail mishap in Rampur as saddening and has directed officials to ensure prompt and adequate treatment for those injured in the accident. He also announced a financial assistance of Rs 50,000 each to seriously injured and Rs 25,000 each to those suffering minor injuries.

The Chief Minister has also asked Minister of State for Irrigation Mr Baldev Singh Olakh to oversee rescue and relief operations. The Chief Secretary, Additional Chief Secretary (health) and Principal Secretary (home) have been asked to effectively monitor the situation emerging after the accident.
