Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath ji visited the residence of martyr Prem Sagar in Teekampur village in Deoria district today. He expressed his condolences to the bereaved family and said that the state government will always stand by them.

During the meeting with the family of the martyr, the Chief Minister also handed over a cheque of Rs. 4 lakh and an FD of Rs. 2 lakh to the wife of the late soldier. Before this, Agriculture Minister Mr. Surya Pratap Shahi has already handed over a financial assistance of Rs. 20 lakh to the family.

The Chief Minister also announced that a girls inter college would be constructed on 1.5 acres of government land and a memorial in the memory of the martyr will also be made. On the remaining land, a park would be constructed and beautified.

He also announced that the '*khadanja*' road linking the village to the main road would be converted into a CC road. To a demand for being allocated a gas agency, the Chief Minister said he will send a recommendation of the same to the union government.
