Mrs. Kalpana Tiwari, wife of late Mr. Vivek Tiwari and other family members, including his two daughters met the Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath ji at his official residence today. The Chief Minister termed the incident as very saddening and extended his deepest sympathies to the bereaved family while assuring them of the strictest action against the perpetrators of the heinous crime.

He further informed the family that the home department and the state police have already been asked to act in this regard. The Chief Minister added that the SIT, constituted by the state government has already begun its probe. Yogi ji also assured the family of all possible help and urged them to have full faith in the state government.

The Chief Minister also directed district officials to provide Rs. 25 lakh as financial assistance to Mrs. Kalpana Tiwari, Rs 5-5 lakh each as fixed deposits to both daughters of Mr. Tiwari and Rs. five lakh to his mother. He also asked officials to ensure speedy handing over of the financial assistance to the family. The Chief Minister also informed that Mrs. Kalpana Tiwari would be given a job at the Lucknow Municipal Corporation.

Instructions have also been issued to adequately solve the problem of residence of the family. Also present during the meeting was deputy Chief Minister Mr. Dinesh Sharma.
