

**Single Stage Transport System to
implement for food grain's door step delivery**
Pilot project to start
in Prayagraj, Banda and Moradabad

Lucknow: August 07, 2020

The Uttar Pradesh Government has taken a decision to implement the Single Stage Transport System in 05 blocks of 03 districts of the state in order to ensure door step delivery of food grains to fair price shopkeepers directly from the Food Corporation of India. In the first phase, this system will be implemented in Saidabad and Shankargarh blocks of Prayagraj, Atarra and Tindwari blocks of Banda and Bhojpur block of Moradabad districts. The Food Commissioner, Shri Manish Chauhan, gave this information here today.

The Food Commissioner said that a comprehensive route chart of fair price shopkeepers will be prepared by the District Marketing Officers to successfully implement the single stage system for door step delivery. He said that vehicles will not be used without GPS system.

Shri Chauhan said that a government order in this regard has been issued. On successful completion of the scheme, all fair price shopkeepers of the state will be linked with it.
